






1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? 433 responses




2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes? 433 responses






3. How well were the teachers able to communicate? 433 responses




4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as 433 responses






5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.




6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?
























19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.
